The diagnosis came as a shock to the family, who were previously unaware of the condition. Initial research revealed limited information regarding effective treatments or a cure.

What is MSA:

Multiple System Atrophy (MSA) is a rare, neurodegenerative disorder impacting multiple bodily systems. Key symptoms can manifest in various combinations, including ataxia (impaired balance and coordination), significant postural hypotension (low blood pressure causing dizziness or fainting upon standing), bladder dysfunction (retention or incontinence), constipation, impotence, difficulties with speech and swallowing, sleep disorders, respiratory issues, and rigidity and tremor resembling Parkinson's disease.
